MTR Welcomes Authorization of Northern Link Main Line Railway Scheme Advance Works in Progress under East Rail Line Kwu Tung Station Project Target Completion in 2034

MTR Corporation welcomes the Chief Executive in Council today (8 April 2025) officially authorizing the Northern Link (NOL) Main Line Railway Scheme under the Railways Ordinance (Cap. 519).

As the backbone of mass transportation in the Northern Metropolis development, the NOL Main Line comprises an approximate 10.7km underground railway connecting Kam Sheung Road Station on the Tuen Ma Line to Kwu Tung Station on the East Rail Line, linking the Tuen Ma Line and the East Rail Line. With the authorization of the railway scheme, the Corporation will finalise the project agreement with the Government as early as possible while continuing to liaise with stakeholders concerned to push ahead with the works.

MTR has commenced the advance works of the NOL in an orderly manner under the East Rail Line Kwu Tung Station project that is underway, in order to expedite the progress of the project, with the target for completion in 2034.
